- **The Board discussed work status of the full-time Road Crew during the COVID-19 outbreak. The state of Ohio has mandated work from home/shelter in place, but while the township work is exempted from that order due to our “essential” designation, we may set a different schedule for the Road employees. The trustees discussed placing the full-time Road crew on a call-in basis, but maintaining their pay. Tasks such as downed trees, graves that need dug, etc. are reasons the crew would be called out. The Ross County Engineer’s office is following a protocol have alternating their work crews daily.**

Motion by Gary Hopkins, second by Larry Kellough to place the two full-time employees of the Road Crew, Terry Wilt and Billy Monroe, on call-in status beginning Thursday, March 26 through Friday, April 10, 2020. They will be paid 40 hours a week, regardless of hours worked and will not be paid an additional amount for call-ins.
